The Council for Cooperation of the Montenegro Government and Non-Governmental Organizations was established as an advisory body of the Government of Montenegro. Some of their tasks are to monitor the implementation of the Strategy for Cooperation of the Government of Montenegro and Non-Governmental Organizations and encourage the involvement of NGOs in the process of public policies making and implementing.

The Council will comprise the chairperson and 24 members, among whom twelve NGO representatives the appointment of whom is underway. The deadline for assigning the candidates is July 10, 2010. All interested ones can find the Public Invitation and Application Forms at the Government of Montenegro Portal, under sections at www.gov.me/biblioteka/oglasj and www.gov.me/biblioteka/obrasci respectively.

- Resident Representative of Montenegro to the United Nations, Ambassador **Milorad Šćepanović** handed over the Letters Credential to the Secretary General of the United Nations.
- In Ljubljana, the Protocol on Cooperation in Education between the Ministry of Education and Science of Montenegro and Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology and Ministry of Education and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia was signed. The Protocol was signed by Minister of Education and Science of the Government of Montenegro Mr. **Slavoljub Stijepović**, on behalf of Montenegro, and Minister of Education and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia Mr. **Igor Lukšić**, on behalf of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology and Ministry of Education and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia. The signed Protocol is aimed at encouraging cooperation of the two states in the areas of primary, secondary, two-year post secondary and higher education via supporting the cooperation and reinforcing the contacts between the Bureaus for Education Services, universities and institutions of higher education of Montenegro and of the Republic of Slovenia.



- Within the framework of the regular visits to municipalities of Montenegro, Minister of Tourism Mr. **Predrag Nenezić** and his associates stayed in a visit to the Municipality of Ulcinj. The meeting with the Mayor of the Municipality of Ulcinj Mr. **Gzim Hajdinaga** and his associates concluded that Ulcinj was ready for the upcoming tourism season.

June 5th

- In the 23rd Standing Conference of Ministers of Education of Europe, organized by the Council of Europe and Ministry of Education and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia, which was

held 4 -5 June 2010 in Ljubljana, the Memorandum of Understanding on the Role and Organization of Education Reform Initiative in South-East Europe (ERI SEE) was signed. On behalf of the Ministry of Education and Science of Montenegro, the Memorandum was signed by Minister **Slavoljub Stijepović**.

- Promotion of the Judicial Information System (PRIS) was held. The Judicial Information System will ensure, among other things, a faster receiving of enactments and documents, a better cooperation of those engaged in judicial process, and a more effective electronic assignment of cases to judges. During the promotion, Deputy Prime Minister for Economic Policy and Financial System and Minister for Information Society Mr. **Vujica Lazović** and Minister of Justice Mr. **Miraš Radović** delivered their respective speeches.

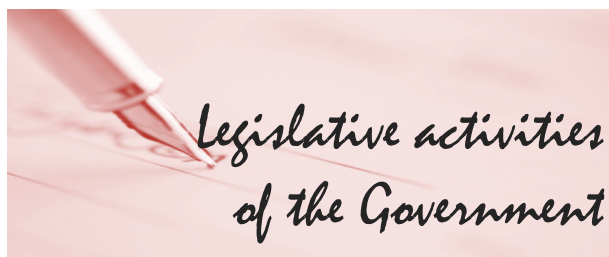
June 14th

- Prime Minister of the Government of Montenegro Mr. **Milo Đukanović** talked to the Vice Chairwoman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress of the Republic of China and President of the All-China Women's Federation Madame **Chen Zhili**. "China is ready to support the development of Montenegro in all areas", said the Vice Chairwoman. The cooperation of the two countries has already been established in the areas of maritime affairs, information technology and telecommunication. Over the coming period, the contractual basis of the two countries will be strengthened further by agreements in the areas of health, education and defense.
- The First Meeting of the Stabilization and Association Council (SA Council) of the EU and Montenegro was held. The Meeting was chaired by the Secretary of State for the European Union Mr. **Diego López Garrido**, on behalf of the Vice President Mrs. **Catherine Ashton**. Montenegro was represented by Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr. **Milan Roćen**. The Meeting was also participated by Mr. **Štefan Füle**, the Commissioner for Enlargement and European Neighborhood Policy.

- Deputy Prime Minister of the Government Mr. **Igor Lukšić** and President of the Council of the Central Bank of Montenegro Mr. **Ljubiša Krgović** participated in the IMF - World Bank Constituency Meeting in Israel. During the Meeting, a series of bilateral meetings was held, among them also that with the Director of the World Bank Mr. **Ruud Treffers**, Executive Director of the IMF Mr. **Age Bakker**, Minister of Finance of Holland Mr. **Jan Keeds de Jager**, and Sector Director in the World Bank Mr. **Gerrard Coorahan**.
- Minister of Defence Mr. **Boro Vučinić** received the Organizational Director of the World Parachuting Championships Mr. **Viktor Kupljenko** and President of the Aeronautical association of Montenegro Mr. **Predrag Mitrović**. Minister Vučinić emphasized the satisfaction that Montenegro is going to be the host of this-year World Parachuting Championships, which has been planned to take place in Niksic in the late August.
- Within the framework of the activities of Ministry of Tourism, Minister of Tourism Mr. **Predrag Nenezić** and his associates stayed today in the working visit to the Municipality of Herceg Novi. During the meeting with the Major of the Municipality Mr. **Dejan Mandić** and his associates and the representatives of tourism industry, discussions on activities and projects the implementation of which was underway, as well as on those ones that should be launched in as shortest time as possible for the purposes of sustainable development of tourism in Herceg Novi, were held.

June 15th

- Two-day Western Balkan Regional Cross- Border Cooperation Forum was closed in Pržno. The Forum was opened by Minister of European Integration prof. **Gordana Đurović**, PhD, whereas Deputy Head of Unit - Financial Instruments & Contract, Directorate General for Enlargement, European Commission, Mr. **Giannantonio Ballette** addressed the Forum in the introductory session.
- Minister of Labor and Social Welfare and President of the Social Council Dr. **Suad Numanović** took part in the work of International Labor Conference in Geneva. The Conference was held under the organization of the International Labor Organization (ILO). During the Conference, Minister Numanović met Regional Director of the International Labor Organization for Europe Ms. **Susan Hoffmann**.

From June 1st to June 15th, the Government of Montenegro held two ordinary sessions.

At the session held on **June 3rd**, which was chaired by Prime Minister Mr. **Milo Đukanović**, the Government of Montenegro approved, i.e. adopted:

1. Proposal Law on the Central Bank of Montenegro
2. Proposal Law on Deposit Guaranteeing
3. Proposal Law on Amendments and Supplements to the Law on Banks
4. Proposal Law on Amendments and Supplements to the Law on Bankruptcy and Liquidation
5. Proposal Law on the Council for Financial Stability
6. Draft Special Purpose Spatial Plan for Bjelasica and Komovi with Strategic Environmental Impact Assessment and program for Public Discussion
7. Regulation on Putting out of Effects Certain Secondary Legislation, and
8. Decision on Establishing the Working Group for Monitoring the Implementation of the National Strategy for Fighting Trafficking in Humans

Proposal Law on the Central Bank of Montenegro governs more precisely the Constitutional provisions on the status of the Central Bank and continues the implementation of the European System of Central Banks and the European Central Bank' general principles of operating, while taking into account that Montenegro undertook an obligation to adjust gradually the national legislation to the European one and to the newest international practices and standards applicable to the area. In addition to other things, the new legal provisions ensure a full independence of the Central Bank, with the aim to encourage and maintain the financial stability of the system, including also maintaining the sound banking system and safe and effective payment operations. Besides, it prescribes that the Central Bank shall contribute to reaching and maintaining price stability and that, without prejudice to achieving its own goals, it shall support the Government of Montenegro's economic policy implementation, acting at the same time in harmony with the principles of open market and freedom of entrepreneurship and competition.

Amendments and Supplements to the Law on Banks and Amendments and Supplements to the Law on Bankruptcy and Liquidation have proposed the mechanisms of ensuring the Central Bank to prevent and overcome effectively crisis situation in the financial sector, providing thereby regulatory consistency in the area concerned.

Proposal Law on the Council for Financial Stability provides for the establishment of a separate body at national level, the task of which will be to monitor, identify, prevent and mitigate potential system risks in the financial system.



At the session held on June 11th, which was chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Mr. **Igor Lukšić**, the Government approved, i.e. adopted:

1. Proposal Law on Annual Statement of Accounts of the 2009 Budget of Montenegro,
2. Information of the Preparations for the First Meeting of the Stabilization and Accession Council that will be held in Luxembourg on June 14, 2010
3. Information about the Results of the Negotiations Between the Representatives of Ministry of Finance, Podgorica Aluminum Plant (KAP) and Deutsche Bank for the Realization of the Loan Arrangement intended for KAP,
4. Loan Agreement between KAP and Deutsche Bank, for the amount of 22 million of Euros total, for which Montenegro Government will issue the Guarantee, and Security Instrument Agreement between Montenegro and Deutsche Bank,
5. National Program for Early Breast Cancer Diagnosing Program for Provision of Free-of-Charge Text Books for 2010/2010 School Year

During approving **Proposal Law on Annual Statement of Accounts of the 2009 Budget of Montenegro**, it was concluded that the public spending policy in 2009 had been based on fiscal potentials of Montenegro and the projected macro-economic scenario within which financial crisis took place. In its realization, special attention was dedicated both to making public expenditures more cost-effective and to an increase in the share of capital expenditures, as well as to more intensive reform of the sectors of judiciary, education and public administration and to the implementation of the National Program of Integrations of Montenegro into the EU and NATO. Within the framework of the 2009 Budget Policy, a set of fiscal measures was applied with the aim of preventive acting against strong challenges posed by global financial crisis. Such measures contributed significantly to maintaining macro-economic stability, going hand in hand with creating the conditions for an increase in employment in small- and medium-size enterprises, development of new investment projects, restructuring of enterprises and privatization based thereon.

Macro-economic indicators in 2009 pointed out to Gross Domestic Product amounting to 3,003.00 million of Euros, which means that, due to global crisis effects, there was a nominal value drop of 2.68%, whereas the real value one was approximately 5.3%. Inflation rate was 1.5%, whereas the public debt was 38% of the GDP. In addition, the Annual Statement of Accounts revealed that the total consolidated public expenditures in 2009 amounted to 1,524.04 million of Euros; the budget revenues were 1,571.26 million of Euros. Budget deficit of Montenegro in 2009 was 4.4 % of the GNP.



Government and citizens

June 3rd

- Minister of Labor and Social Welfare Mr. **Suad Numanović** received the representatives of "Naša inicijativa" ("Our Initiative") Association of Parents of Children and Youth with Developmental Disorders. During the discussions, they talked about a need to increase care and assistance benefits, personal disability benefits and child benefits, as well as to provide better legal solutions relevant to the employment of persons with disabilities, and to launch new support services for the population concerned.

June 4th

- In the eve of June 5th, i.e. the World Environment Day, Ministry of Spatial Planning and Environment arranged the promotion of "This Country is Our Home" Video Spot, which was taken place on the plateau in front of "Karver" Bookshop. During the presentation, Minister of Spatial Planning and Environment Mr. **Branimir Gvozdenović** addressed the gathering. The promotion was participated by civil servants from the institutions dealing with environment protection, NGOs, singers, actors, sportsmen, as well as children from "Ljubica Popović" Kindergarten. The children from the Kindergarten made "THIS COUNTRY IS OUR HOME" patchwork logos, which were given as gifts to the Ministry of Spatial Planning and Environment, Environmental Protection Agency, Public Company for the National Parks of Montenegro and Institute for the Protection of Nature.



June 7th

- Public Invitation for Non-Governmental Organizations to assign their respective representatives to the Council for Cooperation of the Montenegro Government and Non-Governmental Organizations was published, with the deadline by June 10, 2010.

June 8th

- Prime Minister of the Government Mr. **Milo Đukanović** met with chairpersons of branch unions and independent unions that are active within the Confederation of the Trade Unions of Montenegro (SSCG).

June 9th

- Ministers of Defense of Montenegro and Cyprus, Mr. **Boro Vučinić** and Mr. **Costas Papacostas** respectively, delivered the lecture today on the theme of "Defense System – Cyprus and

Montenegro Experience" at the Faculty of Humanist Studies of the University of Donja Gorica in Podgorica.

- Organized by the Social Council, the presentation of the research outcomes from the Project titled "Mobbing in Montenegro" was held. During the presentation, Chairperson of the Social Council and Minister of Labor and Social Welfare Mr. **Suad Numanović** addressed the gathering.
- Minister of Labor and Social Welfare Mr. **Suad Numanović** received the representatives of the "Center for the Rights of the Child".

June 11th

- Ministries of Education and Information Society, Examination Center and the Bureau for International Educational and Scientific Cooperation awarded 64 primary and secondary school pupils and students for one of the first three places won in the National Competition in Knowledge.
- Prime Minister of the Government Mr. **Milo Đukanović** received today the Montenegrin mountaineers **Marko Blečić**, **Dordije Vujičić** and **Dragutin Vujović**, members of the "Javorak" Mountaineering and Skiing Club, Nikšić, who recently climbed to the top of Mount Everest.

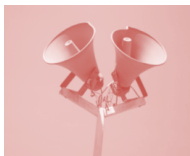

Cetinje, April 11, 1910

To the attention of: Minister of Finance and Building Structures, Mr. Dušan Vukotić – Cetinje

National Parliament, upon considering the 1910 Budget of Public Revenues and Expenditures, as well as the Report by the Financial Committee on the 1910 Budget, approved, in the principle debate of their 18th Ordinary Session held on December 1909, the Decision made by the Committee and given on page no. 4 of their Report, i.e. the sale of the state-owned properties, which Decision reads as follows:

"National Parliament shall empower Mr. Minister of Finance and Building Structures to sell the state-owned properties, since the selling prices are favorable at the very moment, and to invest the moneys earned therefrom into the state-owned Hipotekarna Banka (Mortgage Bank) to be established, from which transaction the state, without a doubt, would have a higher benefit."

By acquainting you with the said Decision, you are kindly asked, Mr. Minister, to accept it cordially and to take care to make possible its enforcement as soon as possible.

I am presenting, Mr. Minister, my highest compliments to you.
